Competitions

An annual trophy will be awarded for each of the following categories:

Colour Prints; Mono Prints; Projected Images

There are 3 rounds with up to 3 entries per member per round in each category. Every entry scores 1 point with an additional 5 for 1st place, 3 for 2nd, 2 for 3rd and 1 for Highly Commended.

In each category the member with the highest total of points at the end of round 3 wins the trophy.

In addition there are trophies for:

Best Print of the Year (Mono or Colour)

Best Projected Image of the Year

These are judged after the 3rd Round. Any image that has been placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd or Highly Commended in earlier rounds may be submitted.

Only images captured within two years of the date of submission to the competition are eligible. This includes images derived from slides and prints which pre-date the two years.

Humorous Image of the Year

A trophy in memory of Richard Burden, a past member, will be awarded to the most humorous image. Any image may be entered.

A full set of rules may be obtained from the club.

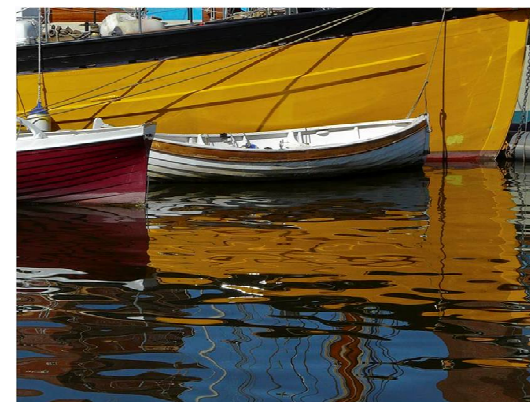
